

The Pennsylvania 2010 Swim In

June 17th to the 20th



To be held in the heart of the beautiful (and very rural) Pennsylvania Mountains at Lake Raystown, the largest lake in Pennsylvania. Opened in 1974; 8,300 acres were used to create a 30 mile long lake with 110 miles of shoreline. Where: Lake Raystown Resort. Check out www.raystownresort.com for a tour of the resort.

- **On Site Lodging:** Negotiated rates. Campgrounds (\$41 per night plus tax), lodge rooms (\$81 per night plus tax) and cabins (price varies one week minimum) all overlooking the lake. Only a limited number of campsites & lodge rooms are on hold. When they are gone no others will be available. Don't hesitate! Note: accommodations through Ron & Val.
- **Entertainment / Restaurants:** The following are located on the property: a small water park, pool, mini golf, site seeing paddleboat, marina, restaurant, pizza shop, boat rentals, beach, general store, etc.
- **Boating / Ramps:** There are many no wake areas located throughout the resort and entire lake with several boat ramps close by.

Tentative Schedule of Events:

- Thursday: Arrive, settle in and explore the resort, dinner on your own at the marina followed by the hand feeding of the HUGE catfish. Check out a few of the local ramps, possibly a paddleboat ride, campfire, etc.
- Friday: Tour to the Raystown lake overlooks, followed by a swim at nearby Snyder's run ,then off to Swigart's Auto Museum www.swigartmuseum.com (oldest in the USA). Private tour of the storage buildings with many rare one of kind and movie vehicles. On the way back we will explore a few ramps. Dinner on your own followed by a campfire.
- Saturday: Tour to Penn's Cave www.pennscave.com , America's only all water cave that is explored by boat. On the way back we will explore a few ramps and then back to resort for a barbeque. Dusk / night swim, in the lake surrounding the resort followed by a campfire.
- Sunday: Swim over to the marina restaurant for breakfast buffet and say goodbyes to those departing.
