

SACRAMENTO, CA

September 4-7 (Fri - Mon)

(Labor Day Weekend)

Fri PM -- Meet at Joe Swinger's any time after 3:00 PM for get acquainted. 6:00 PM informal pot luck dinner and get acquainted. If you cannot be here by 6:00PM, no problem, simply show up when you can.

We will pass out some form of identification and information on how to get to the various locations where we will be meeting. If you cannot make it until Saturday, join us any time during our Saturday sight seeing or at dinner.

Sat -- 9:30 AM Meet at Discovery Co Park. Swim from Discovery Park down the Sacramento river, past Old Sacramento to the Sacramento Marina sightseeing as we go. Land at southern tip of Sacramento Marina,(3.4 Mi with the current). Drive back to Old Sacramento, park where you can. 12:30 meet at Joe's Crab Shack for lunch, (Optional). PM Sight-see, or tour Museum -- 6:30 PM Meet at Elephant Bar, (Optional).

Sun -- 9:00 AM Meet at Nimbus Flat, (fish hatchery and boat ramp), or at Willow Creek. Free rides and/or swim for fun in western end of Lake Natoma. Lunch, 12:30 PM at Negro Bar, about 4.5 miles from Nimbus Flat, (bring your own lunch). After lunch, free rides and/or swim for fun in eastern half of lake. 6:30 PM, meet at Joe's for BBQ.

Mon -- 9:00 AM Meet at Beals Point . Free rides and/or swim for fun. 11:30 AM meet for sight seeing in Old Folsom. 12:30, lunch at XXXX in Old Folsom. PM Back to Beals Point for more free rides and swimming. 6:30 PM Meet at Joe Swinger's for informal pot luck. (Anyone wishing to get an early start toward home, simply leave whenever you want to.)

Tips -- If you can, get AAA's "Roseville--Folsom" and "Sacramento North--Citrus Heights" maps; they are excellent. Folsom Lake and Old Sacramento have maps that you can get on arrival. Beals Point is the most convenient campsite for tenting, trailers and motorhomes.(~\$23.00 per night for a motorhome.) Reserve early if you want one of these. There are local motels. If anyone wants detailed maps of any of these areas, please contact me and I will fax a copy of the section you need.

To get to Joe's: off I 50 at exit 21, to N on Hazel Ave, 2 Mi to R on Sunset Ave, 0.9 Mi to dead end on Main Ave, L 1 Mi to R on Buffalo, to dead end on Mississippi Bar, R to 5144 on left.
